Pursuant to the Code of Conduct on Multilingualism of 17 November, 2008, the following maximum lengths shall apply to texts submitted for translation:

- (a) Explanatory statements and preparatory working documents
 - 7 pages for non-legislative reports
 - 6 pages for legislative reports
 - 3 pages for legislative opinions
 - (b) Draft motions for resolutions: 4 pages, including recitals but excluding citations
 - (c) 'Suggestions' in non-legislative opinions: 1 page
 - (d) Justifications for amendments: 500 characters
 - (e) Executive summaries: 5 pages
- A page shall be taken to mean a text of 1 500 characters (excluding spaces).
